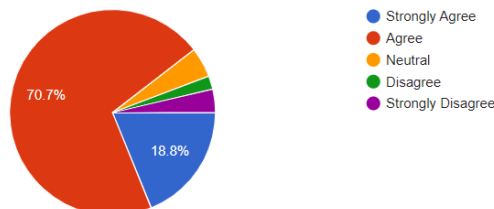


ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK ABOUT SYLLABUS AND IYTS TRANSACTION DURING 2021

- 1. FROM STUDENTS:** about 70.7% students agreed that the Syllabus is optimally designed for Undergraduate standard. 61.8% students agreed that the curriculum is designed to enhance the employability of the students. 54.5 % students believe that the teachers use Modern teaching aids, power point presentations, web-resources, multi-media, e-content during teaching learning process etc. The assessment and evaluation process is fair and unbiased was agreed by 60.6% students and 9.3% strongly agree with this. 65.3% students agreed that the teachers give regular and timely feedback on the performance of the students. However only 59.1% students believe that the teachers encourage students participate in extra-curricular, co-curricular activities and research projects

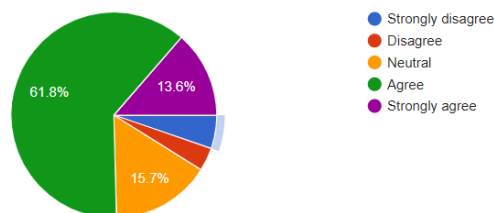
The Syllabus is optimally designed for Undergraduate Level/Standard

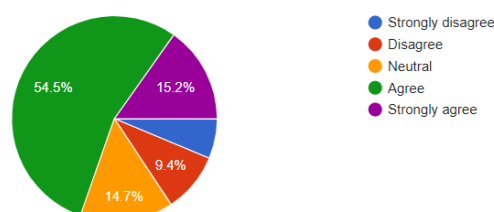
The curriculum is designed to enhance the employability of students

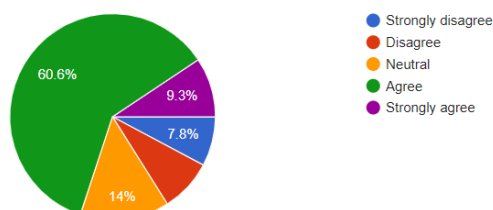
Modern teaching aids, power point presentations, web-resources, multi-media, e-content etc. are used by most of the teachers while teaching

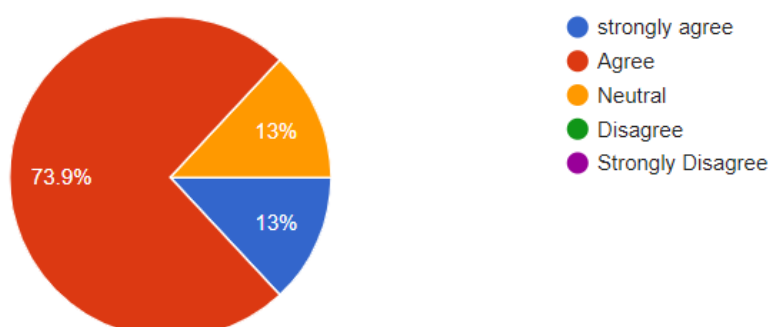

2. **FROM TEACHERS:** 86.9% teachers are in synergy that the syllabus taught is as per the need of students and 95.7% teachers believe the courses taught are in conformity with the learning outcomes . Only 21% teachers have been part of designing of the curriculum and 77.8% believe that the curriculum development procedure needs improvement. 43.4% teachers agree that the curriculum provides opportunity for the conducting research and project related activities.

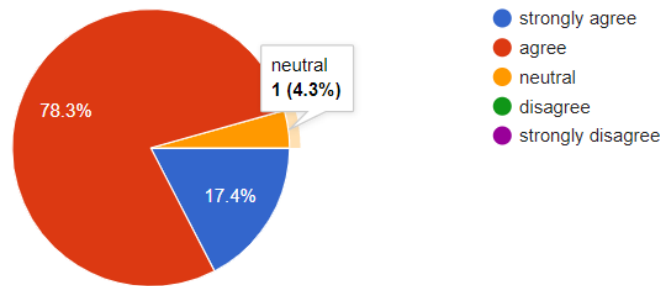

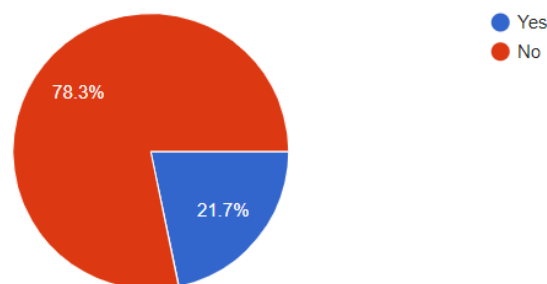
The contents of the course are in conformity with the learning outcomes

Have you participated in the designing of syllabus?

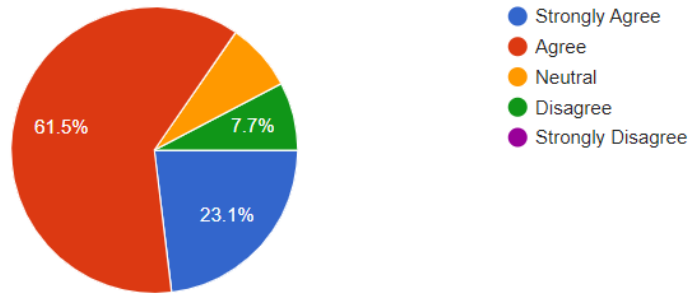

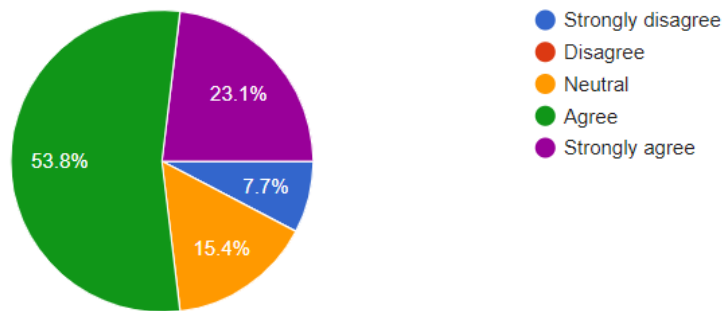
The Syllabus studied by me was relevant to my professional life.
