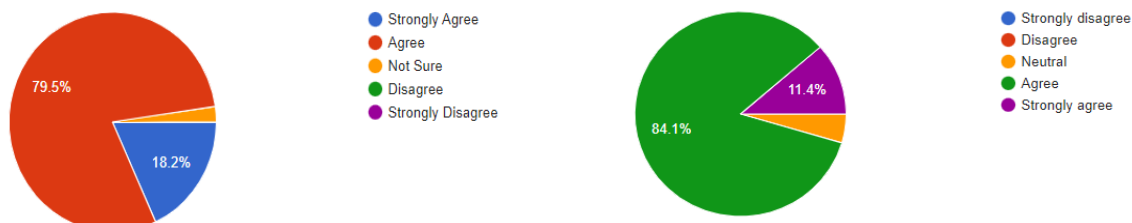


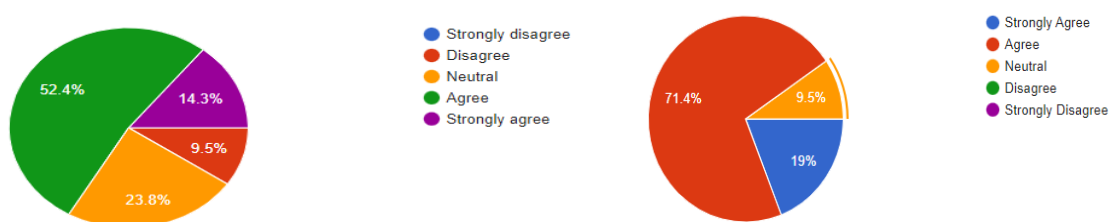
## Students

About 79.5% students agreed that the Syllabus is optimally designed for Undergraduate Level. The contents of the syllabus are relevant and revised at appropriate time was agreed by 81% students. 77.8 % students believe that the teachers use Modern teaching aids, power point presentations, web-resources, multi-media, e-content etc. are used by most of the teachers while teaching. However only 52.3% students believe that the teachers encourage students participate in extra-curricular, co-curricular activities and research projects
