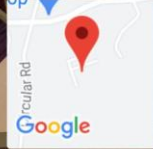
#### *Special lecture on career guidance entitled “what after graduation”*

Department of Botany Government Degree College for Women Pulwama in collaboration with IQAC organized a special lecture on career guidance entitled “what after graduation” on 30-7-2022 at 11.30 am in the conference hall of the college. The resource person of the programme was Dr. Khalid Ul Rehman Hakeem who is working as Professor at King Abdulaziz University Saudi Arabia. Worthy Principal of the college Prof (Dr) Yasmeen Farooq presented a welcome address in which she highlighted the importance of career guidance and developing entrepreneurship skills among students. She welcome the resource person and all the participants present in the programme. Resource person informed the students about a forum known as Kashmir Guidance (KG) which is an initiative by a group of international academicians/educators/professionals hailing from Kashmir. This is a apolitical and seriously dedicated organization working to help, guide and support the students for international education and exchange; specifically, and limited to students of J&K. Dr khalid highlighted the basic errors while choosing a career like Parental Pressure, Peer pressure, Mob Mentality, Societal pressure, Status pressure and Marriage pressure which should not influence the choice of students. Dr khalid told about the subjects for secured future like Guidance and Counseling, Computer Science (AI, Robotics, Syber security etc) and Organic Farming etc. Resource person told about the different fellowships which are available and how to prepare for getting such opportunities. Later on he discussed about the entrepreneurship opportunities available for women students from the comfort of their homes. 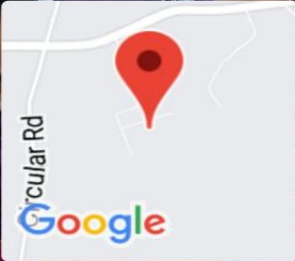

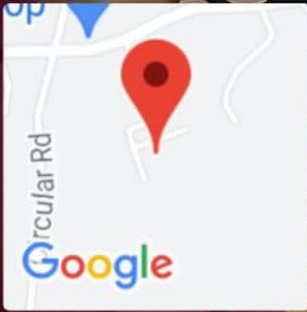
