Student Satisfaction Survey is a metric (2.7.1) is part of criterion II on Teaching – Learning and Evaluation

Utility of the Survey:

The Student Satisfaction Survey primarily focuses on Teaching, Learning, and Evaluation process. It collects in-depth information about a student's satisfaction with the teaching-learning environment of the college. The students' responses are collected and analyzed based on 21 questions designed by NAAC. After going through the question set one understands that the responses collected from students are useful for the restructuring the services offered to students. The results of the survey review the expectations of the students and expert educationalists and the extent to which the College was able to meet these expectations.

About questionnaire:

The questionnaire will be based on the Likert type scale, that means the responses are scaled on a scale of 0 to 4, with the most positive response being rated as 4 and the most negative response being rated as 0. The score emerging out of the survey is part of the second criterion on Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, out of the seven NAAC criteria. The questionnaire consists of several facets of the teaching learning process. Questions vary from specific teaching skills of the teacher to his overall approach to the educational process. The specific skills of the teacher like subject knowledge, communication skills, class preparation, and use of ICT tools are part of the questionnaire. The overall approach of the teacher and institution

with respect to providing the right environment, motivation, interpersonal relationships,

feedback etc. forms the second major component of the questionnaire. Twenty of the twenty-

one questions are objective in nature, while one question is open-ended to elicit observations

and suggestions for improvements providing an opportunity to the student to give

suggestions and criticisms in their own words.

Method used:

This year (2023) also, the Student Satisfaction Survey was online using google form. The

google form link was shared with all the semesters (Sem. I, III, and V), the specific month

was chosen so that the teaching learning was at its end, and it is possible for students to

retrospect and provide correct responses. Each question in the NAAC SSS format is aimed at

collecting factual opinion of students on curriculum, completion of syllabus, preparedness of

the teachers, reaction of the students regarding pedagogy, attitude of teachers, transparency

and fairness in internal evaluations, placement possibilities, curricular and extra-curricular

activities, overall impression and suggestions about the college. Each question in the survey

is one or the other educational goal. This simple but important exercise helps to improve the

relevance of teaching and learning. This survey corresponds to institute level feedback on

infrastructure and learning experience.




Overall Teaching Learning Process







How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 276 responses










How well did the teacher prepare for the class? 275 responses




Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teacher. 274 responses














Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teacher. 266 responses












Availability and accessibility of online educational resources in college.







